Study Guide July 8, 2018

Monday July 9th (I took time to pray today \Box) Read: I Thessalonians 5:16-18

The formula seems easy: be joyful, pray continually, give thanks. Why is it then that we seem to struggle with all three of these? If we at least pray continually, the others will fall in line more easily. Our relationship with Jesus, through constant prayer, helps us to be joyful more often and want to give thanks for all we have seen Jesus do.

Question: Will you be committed to praying more than you do now, knowing it strengthens our relationship with Jesus and helps us to live joyful and thankful lives?

Tuesday July 10th(I took time to pray today \Box)Read: Luke 9:62We have begun a new season here. Thereis no use looking back but we should look ahead to what Godhas planned for us. Being involved in the work of the Kingdom isvery rewarding and will strengthen our knowledge of who God isand how He desires to continue His work through us even today.

Question: Are you ready and willing to look ahead and see where you fit into the plans and mission that will be revealed for Tabor Church?

Question: Will you commit to taking the time in prayer and asking God to reveal to You His call upon your life? Will you ask Him to give you the strength you need to be obedient to whatever that call may be? **Thursday July 12th** (I took time to pray today \Box) **Read: Isaiah 26:4** Another reason prayer is so important. Put that together with reading your Bible daily to discover the character of God. How can we trust a God who we do not know intimately? When we do get to know Him, we will find Him to be faithful and we can trust Him with whatever our situations are.

Question: Are you willing to commit to knowing God more intimately so that we can learn to trust Him with everything? This may seem easier than you think. But experience has taught me that trusting God is a process we go through as we lean about His character and experience Him in all of our difficult situations.

Friday July 13th (I took time to pray today □) Reread: I Cor. 13:1-13 Here is the Scripture that we heard on Sunday. Love is very important because from it so much good flows. Loving people who we are afraid of, who have been unkind to us, who we don't understand can turn situations from bad to good. Love changes things for the better.


