

Study Guide September 24, 2018

Monday September 24th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Luke 6:40 Just because someone is teaching, does not mean that they are above you nor are you, the student, above the teacher. It reminds me of the Scripture that we all have a part to play in the body of Christ.

Question: What is your part in the body of Christ? Are you willing to allow someone else to lead? Are you willing to sometimes be the student?

Tuesday September 25th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Proverbs 11:25 We can be blessed two ways according to this verse. We will prosper when we are generous and we will be refreshed by refreshing others. Sometimes we are called to refresh others as the teacher and sometimes we are called to be refreshed as the student.

Question: Will you only be a part of a small group if you get to lead? Is it difficult to think of yourself as a student, rather than a leader? How about the other way around?

Wednesday September 26th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Proverbs 22:6 It is important to be training up the children that God has given to us in our families but also in the Church. It is our hope that they would grow up remembering all the values we have taught them and that they will remember those values and Scripture the rest of their life.

Question: Are you willing to train up the children here at Tabor? Will you be an encourager and mentor to the young Moms here?

Thursday September 27th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 John 2:27 This confirms the importance of teaching. Even as adults we need to be taught so that what we have been taught about God will provide an anointing which will remain in us. It is also a reminder that we should always abide in Christ.

Question: What does it mean for you to abide in Christ? How much time do you spend in the presence of God? Will you set aside time to just be quiet in the presence of God?

Friday September 28th (I took time to pray today)

Read: John 14:26 The Holy Spirit is also one who teaches us and will be there to remind us of what we have heard. This is another reason why it is important to sit under a teacher so that the Holy Spirit can teach us through that teacher and will remind us of what we have learned.

Question: Are you willing to commit to being part of a small group where you can learn and grow Spiritually? Will you take the time to sit and listen for what the Holy Spirit desires to say to you?

Prayers For The Week

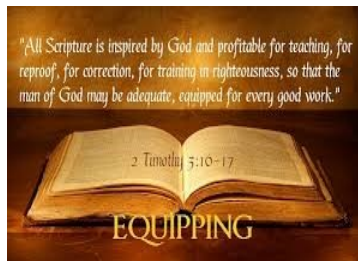
Monday: Lord, I desire to be a part of the body here at Tabor. Show me where you want me to fit in. Amen.
