

## Study Guide

October 1, 2018

**Monday October 1st** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Mark 9:38-50** We are called to encourage one another, not criticize others. When someone does something in Jesus' name, they cannot then turn and say anything negative about Him. So the person who receives the blessing is encouraged by it and will tell others about it. This is something that we should always allow to be continued on.

**Question:** Are you more concerned about what people are doing more than the results that they accomplish? Are you willing to change your focus as you look at others?

**Tuesday October 2nd** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Isaiah 42:1** What a great reminder of how God has called each of us and will put His Spirit on us to do His work. Learn to trust this as God calls you to do things beyond what you feel comfortable doing.

**Question:** Are you willing to trust God in all that He is calling us to do? Do you believe He will equip you especially if He has us leading others to Him?

**Wednesday October 3rd** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Judges 6:14** Another reminder that God is calling each of us to respond to Him. And again we are reminded that He will provide for us when He sends us.

**Question:** How many times do we have to be reminded of what God is calling us to do? Do you finally understand the calling but don't know if you can do it? What will it take for you to get to that place of **knowing** He is there with you?

**Thursday October 4th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Jeremiah 1:9** There are many who are fearful speaking about Jesus to others. They are afraid they may not know what to say. But this verse says that God will put the words in our mouth when we speak to others.

**Question:** Are you afraid you will stumble when you talk to others about Jesus? Can you rely on Jesus to speak to your heart and put the words in your mouth? If not, what will it take?

**Friday October 5th** (I took time to pray today )

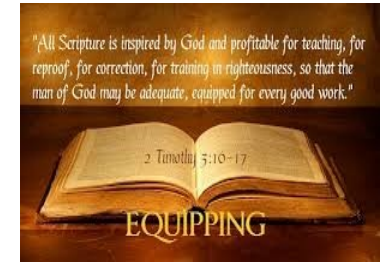
**Read: 2 Timothy 2:20-21** Sometimes we think of ourselves as capable of doing great things and other times we look at ourselves as not being able to do anything. When we cleanse ourselves of those negative thoughts, God will use us for great purposes, providing us with all that we need.

**Question:** *Are you willing to stop allowing the negative thoughts about yourself to take over? Will you allow the thoughts that God desires to use you for His kingdom purposes to be the thoughts that are in the front of your mind?*
