Study Guide

October 22, 2018

Monday October 22nd (I took time to pray today □) Read: Acts 16:22-30 Even in the midst of their circumstances, the humiliation of being stripped and beaten, Paul and Silas found time to pray and sing hymns to God. And the outcome was that a whole household was saved.

Question: Do you find it difficult to praise God no matter what circumstances you find yourself in? What will it take to continue to pray and sing songs of praise to God in all of life's circumstances?

Tuesday October 23rd (I took time to pray today \square) **Read:** Luke 10:27 The command is very clear. We are to love the Lord our God with all of our heart, soul, mind and strength and to love your neighbor as yourself.

Question: Do you struggle loving God with all of your heart, soul, mind and strength? Neighbor means more than those who live next to you. Can you love everyone you come in contact with? If this is difficult for you, are you willing to reflect inwardly and see what it would take to change?

Wednesday October 24th (I took time to pray today ☐)
Read: Luke 4:8 We are called to worship God only.
We are not called to worship our car, our money, our job, our family, ourselves, etc.

Question: Do you put other things or people ahead of God? Do you believe that this is a form of Worship? Are you willing to look at your Worship of God more closely?

Thursday October 25th (I took time to pray today □) Read: Psalm 84:10 Being in the courts of the Lord is better than anything although this Scripture makes it seem a bit easier by using the tents of wickedness as a comparison.

Question: Can you honestly say that you love being in the presence of God more than anything? Would you only desire to be in His presence more than anything if the alternative was far worse than being there?

Friday October 26th (I took time to pray today □) **Read: Psalm 27:4** Another Scripture illustrating the importance of being with God. This Psalm goes a bit further and says that we should seek after God, dwell in His house and to gaze upon His beauty.

Question: Can you see yourself being in the presence of God this way? What if your life were threatened if you were found worshipping your God? Would you still worship Him and desire to be with Him?
