November 5, 2018

Monday November 5th (I took time to pray today □) Read: Mark 12:28-34 Here Jesus tells us the Greatest Commandment, to love God with all of our heart, soul, mind and strength and to love our neighbor as ourselves. It may sound simple but sometimes it is hard to do this. You have to give all you are to God all the time.

Question: Is this difficult or easy for you to do? Are you willing to surrender and make this commitment if you struggle doing this? Isn't it interesting that a similar Scripture was used a few weeks ago? Maybe it is a reminder that this is something for us to consider more.

Tuesday November 6th (I took time to pray today □) **Read:** I **Cor. 12:12-31** This Scripture definitely says that all of us are to be a part of the church body. We all have different gifts that benefit the church. Take time to look at how you are to serve in the body of Christ.

Question: Are you doing your part in the body of Christ? Are you willing to spend time with God and ask Him what your gifts are and how they can be used in the body of Christ? If, yes, then DO IT!!!

Wednesday November 7th (I took time to pray today □) Read: Ephesians 4:4 This Scripture makes it clear that there is only one body and one Spirit that each of us is called to. And in this calling we have one hope.

Question: What does it mean to you when it says that there is only one body and one Spirit? Do you desire to be a part of that one body? If you do, how will you accomplish this?

Thursday November 8th (I took time to pray today □) Read: Colossians 1:18 The NIV Bible has a heading over this section "The Supremacy of Christ". This is a great reminder that Christ is head over the church universal and Tabor Church. Sometimes we put others over the church leaving Christ out of the picture.

Question: Are you willing to allow Christ to lead our church in where it should go and what it should be doing? Are we willing to make our leaders accountable to be following Christ as He is the head of the church?

Friday November 9th (I took time to pray today □) **Read: Ephesians 2:19-22** Wow, we are not foreigners or aliens but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household. That means that no one person is better than us. We are all equal and not to be excluded from the rest of God's family.

Question: Do you sometimes feel left out of the family of God? What can the church family do to make you feel an equal and included part of the family? If there is something specific you came up with, are you willing to share it with the leaders of the church so that we can be better at including all people?

We are reminded of God's love for us each Sunday that we receive Holy Communion. Through God's love for us we can't help but want to serve others and show that love to them.
