**Monday November 12th** (I took time to pray today  $\Box$ ) **Read: Mark 12:38-44** This is the story of Jesus observing people putting in their offering at the Temple. He does not say anything until the widow comes along and puts in her offering. His comment is she puts in all that she had while the wealthy put in out of their wealth.

**Question:** Do you find this to be a difficult passage of Scripture? Our money and possessions can sometimes be The main focus in our lives. How difficult is it for you to give away your money and possessions?

**Tuesday November 13th** (I took time to pray today  $\Box$ ) **Read: Philippians 4:19** Yesterday we were asked how difficult it would be to give our money and possessions away. Today we are reminded that God will meet all of our needs. All we have to do is trust God and believe His promises to make it easier to give away what we have.

**Question:** Do you truly believe the promises of God? If you do, what are you doing to live like you trust God for all of your needs? If you do, are you also willing to give to the church and others?

**Wednesday November 14th** (I took time to pray today  $\Box$ ) **Read:** Malachi 3:10 What an encouraging Scripture. It says that we will be blessed abundantly when we give to the church. This would also include others. We may not mind giving what we have away but usually it is something that won't affect us negatively by giving it away.

**Question:** Have you personally seen God bless you especially after you have blessed someone? What about blessing Tabor Church? Do you believe that we are all called to support the church both financially and in our service? If so, are you willing to reflect on what you are doing now?




