

## Study Guide

April 1, 2019

**Monday April 1st** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Luke 15:1-3, 11b-32** Although some of the parables are hard to understand, this one is straight forward. It is a reminder that even when we walk away from God, He still welcomes us back with open arms.

**Question:** How does it make you feel knowing that God loves you no matter what? Don't you think you should tell others about this unconditional love?

**Tuesday April 2nd** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Luke 15:6-17** Another reminder of the love of God for us. There is great rejoicing that happens when something that is lost is found. This is how God reacts to us when we have found Him or come back to Him.

**Question:** How does it make you feel to know that God rejoices over you when you return to Him or for those who find Him for the first time? Do we as Tabor Church act that way when someone returns to Tabor?

**Wednesday April 3rd** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Luke 15:31-32** We aren't normally called to keep reading the same Scripture over and over. Maybe we are having reinforced in us the importance of remembering how God delights in us returning to Him.

**Question:** Let's change things around; how do you feel about the reminder that those of us who are always with the Father, are entitled to everything? How will your life change knowing that because we are currently with God that everything He has we are entitled to?

**Thursday April 4th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Matthew 8:18-22** There is a cost to following Jesus. As we have read, there are also benefits to following Jesus. But remember from the previous day's Scriptures that were Read. God's love for us is unconditional.

**Question:** Are you willing to pay the cost to follow Jesus? Is there anything you need to do to become a follower of Jesus? or do you need to change anything in your life to be more of a follower of Jesus?

**Friday April 5th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Matthew 19:25-26** Well I think our question about the cost of following Jesus is answered here. Although there may seem like a cost to be a follower, the prize is our Salvation, spending eternity with Jesus.

**Question:** Are you willing to pay the cost of following Jesus so that you too will be saved? Can you answer the question, "If I were to die tomorrow, would you spend eternity with God in heaven?" with a definite YES? If not, are you willing to talk to someone to be sure?

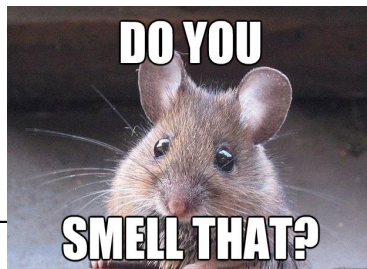
