Monday April 15th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Isaiah 50:4-9a How comforting that God provides His word to sustain the weary, opens our ears to Him and provides comfort and help. The big reminder is that we need to not only read His word but to comprehend it as well because there is so much truth in it.

Question: Are you willing to commit to reading His word daily? Do you struggle hearing from God? If so, maybe you have not studied enough of His word to make His truths sink in and stick.

Tuesday April 16th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Jeremiah 29:11 This is a great Scripture to memorize. It is a Scripture that can lift you up when you are down. It tells you who God is and promises you that God will provide you with hope and a future.

Question: Do you struggle with accepting that God has only good for you? Can you accept that He has plans to prosper you and not to harm you? How does this Scripture make you feel?

Wednesday April 17th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 139:16-17 The importance of God's words to us is stressed in this Psalm. But you will only know what God is saying to You if you read His Word, study it and apply it to your life.

Question: What steps will you take to spend more time in God's Word? Have you heard God speak to you and thought that His Words to you were precious? If not, why not?

Thursday April 18th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Matt. 10:29-31 We are told that we are worth more than two sparrows, that nothing will happen apart from God and even the hairs of our head are all numbered.

Question: How does it make you feel to know that God is that connected to you so that He knows the number or hairs on your head? How do you feel knowing that He cares for you more than sparrows and will not allow anything to happen apart from Him?

Friday April 19th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Ephesians 2:10 According to this Scripture, we are created to do good works which God has prepared for us to do.

Question: How did this Scripture make you feel knowing that you are God's workmanship? How have you been in doing good works? Have you seen God prepare you to do good works and how have you responded?
