Monday April 28th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: John 20:19-31 This Scripture reminds us that when Jesus shows up anything can happen. The doors were locked, but Jesus still showed up. Jesus breathed on them and told them to receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. Although Thomas doubted this story when he was told by the Disciples, Jesus showed up again to allow Thomas to see that He had risen.

Question: Have you ever sensed Jesus show up in the middle of your doubts and questions? Is there anything you need to do to be more assured that Jesus is with you no matter what? Do you doubt that Jesus can do anything? If yes, what are you going to do to be more trusting of Jesus?

Tuesday April 29th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 John 1:8 Simply stated, if we think we are without sin, we deceive ourselves, and there is no truth in us.

Question: What is your response to this verse? Do you see yourself as a person that is without sin? Do you critique yourself and say some of your sins are not that bad compared to others? How often do you seek God's forgiveness?

Wednesday April 30th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Ephesians 1:13-14 Once you have been included with Christ, we are marked with a seal with the promised Holy Spirit, and are guaranteed our inheritance when we are in God's possession.

Question: Are you convinced that you are in God's possession? How does it make you feel to know that you are marked with a seal and guaranteed an inheritance with Christ?

Thursday May 1st

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Corinthians 3:4-6 Each of us are a seed that someone else planted and watered but that God made grow. We should not hold in high esteem those who helped the process of planting and watering. The most important part is the growing process that God is involved in.

Question: Do you put a higher value on those around you who have helped you in your Spiritual journey than you do on God? Have you made God a top priority in your life?

Friday May 2nd

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Kings 17:24 Because Elijah healed a young boy from death, this Scripture shows a Mother that the prophet Elijah was a great man of God and speaks the truth.

Question: How do you think God sees you? How do you think others see you? Are you living a life that others know for sure that you are a Christian? Through your witness, are you showing others who God is?
