Sunday May 12th (I took time to pray today)

Read: John 10:22-30 The Jews still are not convinced that Jesus is who He says He is. They have seen the miracles but still they do not believe that He is the one promised.

Question: Is your relationship with Jesus secure enough to really know who He says He is? Are you willing to encourage others with the knowledge you have of who Jesus is? Or, do you still question that Jesus can do what He has promised?

Monday, May 13th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Eccl. 7:9 We are encouraged not to allow ourselves to be provoked or else anger may reside in us.

Question: How well do you handle your anger? Do you only become angry at home or do you show it outside the home as well? Are you easily provoked? What can you do to not allow this to have an affect on you?

Tuesday, May 14th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Galatians 6:9 Continue to do good and don't give up. When we do this we will reap the benefits.

Question: Do you struggle with the energy you need to keep doing good no matter where you are? What would it take to convince yourself that you have what it takes to be a blessing to another?

Wednesday, May 15th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 37:7-9 We are called to hope in the Lord and be still with Him, Because He will help us when we fret or become angry.

Question: Who do you go to when you become angry or are fretting about something? Is your first response to go to Jesus or to a family member or friend?

Thursday May 16th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 75:2 God is the one who should judge us. Of course we are forgiven through Jesus's blood if we only ask.

Question: Do you have the tendency to judge others? Are you willing to allow Jesus to judge others and leave it all to Him?

Friday May 17th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 2 Thes. 1:4-5 Another reminder that God is the one who should judge others. It says God's judgment is right and is worthy of Him alone even when we are suffering.

Question: Do you believe God's judgment is right? Will you allow Him to do whatever He feels is right in all your sufferings that are related to others?

Saturday, May 18th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 7:1 We should not judge others unless we want to be judged back.

Question: Why is it so easy to judge another especially after they have done something hurtful? Are you willing to try to turn this desire right over to Jesus?
