May 19, 2019

Sunday May 19th (I took time to pray today)

Read: John 13:31-35 In this Scripture, Jesus gives a new command. We are to love one another as Jesus has loved us. If we do this, others will know that we are Jesus' Disciples.

Question: How are you at loving others? Do others recognize you as one of Jesus' followers by your acts of love? If not, what do you need to change?

Monday, May 20th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 29:11 A simple reminder that God gives strength to His people and blesses His people with peace.

Question: Do you believe and act as if this statement of Scripture is true for you? How are you at sensing God's peace in the midst of trouble?

Tuesday, May 21st (I took time to pray today)

Read: Romans 12:18 Simply put, live at peace with everyone.

Question: Is this living at peace with everyone a difficult thing for you to do? What would it take for you to respond more peacefully when faced with someone who opposes all that you try to do?

Wednesday, May 22nd (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Peter 3:9-11 This Scripture goes with the previous two days readings. It actually points out ways we can love and live in peace with others.

Question: Do you desire to inherit a blessing? Can you avoid repaying evil with evil? Can you keep your lips from deceitful speech? Can you pursue peace?

Thursday May 23rd (I took time to pray today)

Read: Isaiah 26:12 All that we have accomplished the Lord has done for us.

Question: How prideful are you? Do you acknowledge that all of your accomplishments come from the Lord? Or do you think you alone are responsible for your accomplishments?

Friday May 24th (I took time to pray today)

Read: John 16:33 It is comforting to know that we may walk in peace because Jesus has overcome the world.

Question: What would it look like to walk in peace? Do you allow Jesus to walk with you so that you will always be at peace? It really is all about trust. So again, how much do you trust Jesus with your life?

Saturday, May 25th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Colossians 3:15 So if the peace of Christ rules in our hearts, we are called to peace. We are also called to be thankful.

Question: What will it take to have the peace of Christ rule in your heart? After all the readings this week, are you willing to take a step towards living at peace with everyone?

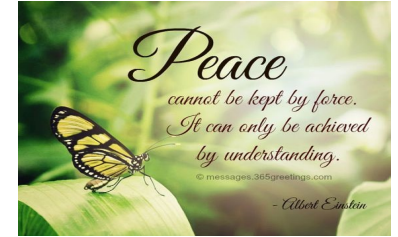
