Sunday May 26th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: John 14:23-29 This the Scripture where Jesus promises us the Holy Spirit. But Jesus also tells us the importance of loving Him. When we love Jesus, Jesus and His Father will come and make a home in us.

Question: What does it look like to love Jesus? Is it merely an emotion or is it a relationship? Who is the Holy Spirit in your life? What will it mean for you to be in relationship with Jesus and the Holy Spirit?

Monday, May 27th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Acts 2:1-5 This Scripture fulfilled Jesus' promise of the Holy Spirit. This Scripture tells of when the Holy Spirit descended on the Disciples who were gathered in the Upper Room.

Question: What is your understanding of the Holy Spirit in your life? If you don't fully understand this relationship, are you willing to discover what this means for you?

Tuesday, May 28th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Luke 24:45-47 Jesus has appeared to the Disciples after His death and reminds them of the promise of the One who will come and clothe them from on high.

Question: We now have seen two promises about the Holy Spirit, why do you think that most people do not want to understand this third person of the Trinity? Do you think there is anything that you should fear about our relationship with God? If you do, what are you going to do about it?

Wednesday, May 29th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 John 2:19-27 This Scripture tells us that one important thing about the Holy Spirit is that He protects us from the evil one and anyone trying to convince us there is no Jesus.

Question: Do you think you are able to recognize the anti-Christ? Do you recognize from these versus the importance of the Holy Spirit?

Thursday May 30th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: John 3:5-6 Here Jesus says that no one can enter the Kingdom unless he is born again by water and the spirit.

Question: Most of us have been baptized with water, but have you been baptized with the Holy Spirit? Do you even understand what this means for you?

Friday May 31st

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Samuel 10:6 Samuel told Saul as he was anointing him king, that Saul would feel the Spirit of the Lord come upon him and that he would be changed.

Question: Do you want to be changed by the Spirit of God? Or are you comfortable where you are in your relationship with God?

Saturday, June 1st

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Haggai 2:5 The prophet Haggai prophesied that the Spirit of the Lord would remain among the people. and not to fear.

Question: Why do we allow the unknown to cause fear in our lives? Are you willing to trust that God has only good in mind for you?
