Read: Isaiah 40:28 God never grows tired or weary and His understanding of all things no one can fully understand.

Question: Have you gathered from this week, a greater understanding of who God is? Do you desire to grow closer through study and quiet time to understand Him more fully?

Read: Acts 1:24 The Disciples prayed to the Lord so that they would know His heart in a decision they were trying to make.

Question: Do you ask God continually for His input when you are making important decisions? Do you understand that God cares about every part of your life? What can you do to make talking to God a daily part of your life?

Saturday, June 15th


(I took time to pray today \Box)
