June 16, 2019

**Sunday June 16th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: John 16:12-15** Jesus tells us that the Spirit of truth will come and guide us into all truth. He will speak only what He hears and tell us what is to come.

**Question:** Does this Scripture bring you comfort knowing that God's Spirit will speak to us and guide us? What will you do differently in your life to hear more regularly from God's Spirit?

**Monday, June 17th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Philippians 4:6-7** This Scripture reminds us that we are not to be anxious about anything but to give our request to God which will give us peace.

**Question:** How do you handle anxiety? Can you trust that God can give you the peace that transcends all understanding? Are you willing to give this a try?

**Tuesday, June 18th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Luke 6:38** Jesus tells us to give to others and a full measure will be given to us, running over into our lap.

**Question:** Is it hard for you to give to others? What are your thoughts about giving so that you will be given? Does your heart need to be changed so that you give because you just care for another?

**Wednesday, June 19th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: 1 Corinthians 10:13** The promise that we will not be tempted beyond what we can bear. But when we are tempted, God will provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.

**Question:** How good are you at facing temptation? Do you stand on the promise that God will provide a way out for us when we are faced with temptation? How will you lean on Him when this occurs?

**Thursday June 20th** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Malachi 3:10** Again, when we give, God will bless us abundantly. God says we can test Him on this.

**Question:** How do you feel about testing God? Have you ever done this? What were the results?

**Friday June 21st** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: 2 Corinthians 9:7** We should not give reluctantly or under compulsion for God loves a cheerful giver. We are reminded that we should give what we have decided in our heart to give.

**Question:** Do you believe that God has given to you generously? How do you show your thankfulness to God for all that He has done for you?

**Saturday, June 22nd** (I took time to pray today )

**Read: Philippians 4:19** Another Scripture to memorize. "...God will meet all of your needs according to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus."

**Question:** Do you think that Scriptures like these only apply to a holy few? Are you willing to memorize this Scripture and be reminded how much God desires to meet our needs in His Time?
