## June 30, 2019

**Sunday June 30th** (I took time to pray today  $\Box$ )

**Read: Luke 10: 38-42** This is the story of Martha and Mary. One thinks both should be working, preparing food for the People, the other thinks it is more important to sit at Jesus' feet.

**Question:** What do you consider to be the most important thing in your life? Is it everything else but being in the presence of God? If it is, are you willing to change what should be your "Main Thing"?

Monday, July 1st (I took time to pray today  $\Box$ )

**Read:** Joshua 24:15 This Scripture is direct and asks the people who they are going to serve. Is it the gods their forefathers served or will they choose serving the Lord God.

**Question:** What or who do you desire to serve? Is it the things of this world, or is your priority to serve God? Do you understand that putting other things before God are idols in your lives?

**Tuesday, July 2nd** (I took time to pray today  $\Box$ )

**Read: Romans 14:17-18** This Scripture tells what the Kingdom looks like and anyone who serves Christ in that way is pleasing to God and approved by men.

**Question:** How are you at righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit? Do you desire to be pleasing to God and approved by men? Can we be approved by men without being pleasing to God? Where do you seek your approval?

Wednesday, July 4th (I took time to pray today  $\Box$ )

**Read: 1 John 4:7-8** A reminder of the importance of loving God because from that we can love one another.

**Question:** How are you at loving God? How are you at loving another? Could you be accused of not loving God? How well do you know God? Is loving others, your "Main Thing"?

Thursday July 5th

(I took time to pray today  $\Box$ )

**Read: 1 John 2:24-25** All that we have heard in God's word should remain in us so that we will remain in the Son and God, which promises us eternal life.

**Question:** Is your main thing eternal life? Do you understand that to get there you have to remain in Jesus and God? How do you think that happens? What do you need to do?

Saturday, June 29th


(I took time to pray today  $\Box$  )
