Sunday July 14th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Luke 10:25-37 This is the story of the Good Samaritan. Several people walked by a man who had been beaten but it was a Samaritan who stopped and took pity on the injured man.

Question: Who do you think is your neighbor? Are you confident that you could show compassion to everyone you came in contact with? Are there those you struggle with by showing compassion? What can you do about this?

Monday, July 15th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Amos 7:7-17 The prophet Amos is being sent away because of what he is prophesizing.

Question: Do we struggle hearing the difficult truth from another? What is your response to those who provide that truth?

Tuesday, July 16th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Peter 4:8 This Scripture says "Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins."

Question: How do you feel about this Scripture? Can you love others deeply so that forgiveness comes naturally for you?

Wednesday, July 17th (I took time to pray today)

Read: John 15:12 This Scripture is part of the Prodigal Son story. The Father grants his son's request and divides up the estate so his son can have his share.

Question: If you are a parent, is it difficult to give in to your child's request when you think it is not good for them? Does love play into this at all? How is your love for your children expressed?

Thursday July 18th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Romans 2:11 A simple Scripture: "For God does not show favoritism."

Question: Does this Scripture change your mind as to how you treat people? If God doesn't show favoritism, should we? What will it take to change your attitude about certain people?

Friday July 19th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Romans 8:31 "If God is for us, who can be against us"?

Question: Does being reminded of this Scripture help you to not take your enemies so seriously? Are you willing to trust God when you feel threatened by an enemy?

Saturday, July 20th (I took time to pray today)

Read: John 6:35-37 This Scripture tells us that Jesus loves us enough to offer us good things as long as we believe.

Question: What have you seen Jesus do in your life? Are you willing to be used by God to offer the good things to others that Jesus has offered to us as believers?
