Sunday, September 1st (I took time to pray today \Box)

Read: Luke 14:1, 7-14 This talks about how we should act when we are invited somewhere like a wedding. But Jesus also tells us we should not invite our friends and rich neighbors but those who are poor, crippled, lame and blind.

Questions: How often have you included those less fortunate than yourself to your home for a meal? Are you one to take the seat of honor when entering another's home or a seat that no one else wants?

Monday, September 2nd (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Peter 2:9 This Scripture tells us we are a chosen people, people belonging to God so that we can declare the praises of Him who called us out of darkness.

Questions: How does it make you feel to be a chosen one of God? Do you declare the praises of God because He has called you out of the darkness?

Tuesday, September 3rd (I took time to pray today \Box)

Read: Jeremiah 29:11 A great reminder Scripture that all of us should know. God's plans for us are for us to prosper, and not to harm us, but plans to give us hope and a future.

Questions: Isn't it important to be reminded that God has only good for us? Do you live like God's plans for us are to prosper and to give us hope and a future?

Wednesday, September 4th (I took time to pray today \Box)

Read: Romans 8:28 God works all things together for His good for those who love Him and are called according to His purposes.

Questions: Do you have that much confidence in God that He works all things together for His good? Do you believe that you are called according to His purposes?

Thursday, September 5th

(I took time to pray today \Box)

Read: Isaiah 46:10 God's purposes will stand and He will continue to do all that He feels is right to do.

Questions: Does it give you comfort knowing that God never changes? How do you feel knowing that His purposes will always stand?

Friday, September 6th (I took time to pray today \Box)

Read: Ephesians 2:10 We have been created to do good works and which God prepared in advance for us to do.

Questions: How does it make you feel to know that you have been created to do good works? Aren't you thankful that God has prepared these good works in advance for you?


Saturday, September 7th (I took time to pray today \Box)
