Sunday, September 15th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Luke 15:1-10 This Scripture tells the parable of the lost sheep and also of the women who lost the coin. It points out the importance of repentance.

Questions: Are you concerned more for the people inside the flock, or outside the flock? Would you be the one going after the one? What would it look like for you to be concerned about the one?

Monday, September 16th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Timothy 1:12-17 Christ came into the world to save sinners. Christ shows His unlimited patience with us by showing His mercy.

Questions: How often do you repent of your sins before God? Is this difficult for you to do or is it just too time consuming? How well do you accept His mercy?

Tuesday, September 17th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 2 Samuel 22:4 We can call on the Lord, who is worthy of praise and saves us from our enemies.

Questions: How are you on calling on the Lord? Do you believe He is worthy of our praise? Do you believe He saves us from our enemies? If yes, what are you doing about it?

Wednesday, September 18th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 17:5 This is the Scripture where God announces that Jesus is His Son and that He is well pleased with Him. It also says that we should listen to Him.

Questions: How well do you do listening to Jesus? Are you more of the one talking or do you take time to listen? Do you recognize the importance of listening?

Thursday, September 19th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Philippian 2:9-11 This Scripture encourages us to exalt Christ. Every knee shall bow and every tongue confess that Jesus is Lord, all which brings glory to God.

Questions: How are you at exalting Christ? How do you bring glory to God? Can you make this part of your daily routine?

Friday, September 20th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Hebrews 3:3 This says that Jesus has been found worthy of greater honor, even more than Moses.

Questions: How much honor do you pay to Jesus? How do you do this? Do you have a greater understanding of how we should come to know and honor Jesus more?

Saturday, September 21st (I took time to pray today)

Read: Revelation 5:9 Another Scripture talking about the worthiness of Jesus because He shed His blood for us.

Questions: How do you praise Jesus? Do believe He is worthy of all our praise? How will you connect more deeply with Jesus?
