Sunday, September 22nd (I took time to pray today \square) Read: Luke 16:1-13 This Scripture has two truths which are hard to swallow. One is that no servant can serve two masters and you can't serve both God and money. Questions: Who do you serve? Do you recognize that you could serve a "thing" rather than a person? Where do you place God in the lineup of all that you do? Monday, September 23rd (I took time to pray today \square) **Read:** Deuteronomy 7:9 A reminder that God is faithful to those who love Him and keep His commandments. **Questions:** How are you at keeping God's commandments? How are you at loving God? Is there anything you need to do different in these two areas of your life? Tuesday, September 24th (I took time to pray today \square) **Read:** Psalm 33:4 We are told that God's word is right and true and again hear that God is faithful in all He does. **Questions:** What does it mean for you to hear that God is faithful? Can you stand on that in difficult times? (I took time to pray today \square) Wednesday, September 25th Read: Psalm 91:4 God will cover you with His feathers and under His wings we will find refuge. Questions: How does it make you feel to know that God

desires to be our refuge? Can you imagine what it means for

God to be our protector?

Thursday, September 26th (I took time to pray today \square) Read: 2 Thessalonians 3:3 Talks about God's faithfulness by protecting us from the evil one. Questions: Has your heart changed towards God's faithfulness? How have you seen God protect you from the evil one? Can you trust Him that He will do this always? Friday, September 27th (I took time to pray today \square) Read: 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just and will forgive us of our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. Questions: Isn't it comforting to know that all we need to do is confess our sins to God and He will forgive us and purify us? Are you seeing the importance of God's faithfulness? Saturday, September 28th (I took time to pray today \square) Read: Romans 8:38-39 Nothing can separate us from the love of God. Questions: Do you struggle with how much God loves you? Will you commit to memorize this Scripture to be reminded of how great His love is for you? Are you really convinced that God loves you even though you look at your past with disgust?
