Sunday, September 29nd (I took time to pray today □) Read: Philippians 2:1-11 We should not do anything out of selfish ambitions but consider others better than ourselves. Our attitude should be the same as Jesus. Questions: Do you find yourself doing things out of selfish ambitions? Do you think yourself better than others? Are you willing to change your attitude so that you are more like Jesus? Monday, September 30th (I took time to pray today \square) **Read:** Mark 20:42-45 Whoever wants to be great among you must be your servant and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. For even Jesus did not come to be served, but to serve. **Questions:** How difficult is it for you to be a servant rather than being served? Maybe you don't do this all the time, but can you remember times when you felt you deserved to be served? Tuesday, October 1st (I took time to pray today □) Read: John 13:12-17 This is after Jesus finishes washing the Disciples feet. He says to them that He has set an example for them so that they can do what He has done. Questions: Do you feel that you still have more to do within yourself in order to be more like Jesus? If yes, are you willing to begin trying? Wednesday, October 2nd (I took time to pray today \square) **Read:** Acts 20:35 It is more blessed to give than to receive.


Questions: Do you agree with this Scripture? Do you try to live this out so that you are giving rather than receiving?

Thursday, October 3rd (I took time to pray today \square) Read: Matthew 20:28 Jesus did not come to be served but to serve and give His life as a ransom. Questions: How difficult do you find it to be more like Jesus? Do you believe it is worth it to change your ways and attitudes to be more like Him? What will you start doing to accomplish this? Friday, October 4th (I took time to pray today □) Read: Luke 22:26 The greatest among you should be like the youngest and the one who rules like the one who serves. Questions: Can you think of a time when you have decided to serve another, who did not deserve it? Were you blessed by doing that? If you were, shouldn't that be a goal to strive for? Saturday, October 5th (I took time to pray today \square) **Read:** Hebrews 13:7 We should remember our leaders who spoke the word of God to us and imitate their faith. Questions: Have there been people in your life who have spoken the word of God to you? Do you try to imitate their faith? Do you look for role models that you can imitate or talk to so that you can be encouraged?
