Monday, October 7th (I took time to pray today \square) Read: 2 Timothy 1:9 God has saved us and called us to a Holy life, not because of anything we have done, but because of His own purpose and grace. Questions: Do you believe that God has a purpose for you? Do you think that purpose will be revealed if you are not at least trying to live a holy life? Do you understand what grace is for you? Tuesday, October 8th (I took time to pray today □) Read: 1 John 3:18 We should not love with words or tongue but with actions and truth. Questions: Which is harder for you, loving with words or with actions? Can you sense the difference? If it is the latter, what are you going to do about it to change? Wednesday, October 9th (I took time to pray today \square)


Read: I Corinthians 15:58 Always give yourself full to the work of the Lord because you know your labor in the Lord is not in vain.


