Sunday, November 10th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 7:3-5 This Scripture talks about us looking first at the plank in our own eye before you look at the speck in your brother's eye.

Questions: How well do you do at this? Are you quicker to judge another before you judge yourself? Are you willing to look at how you treat others differently?

Monday, November 11th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Ephesians 5:22-26 Wives should submit to their husbands as to the Lord and husbands should love their wives as Christ loves the church and gave Himself up for her.

Questions: Is your marriage relationship similar or comparable to your relationship to the church? How are you at giving the Church priority as you do your family? On your list of priorities, where does the church fall?

Tuesday, November 12th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Ephesians 5:32-33 Husbands should love their wife as he loves himself and wives must respect her husband.

Questions: Do you see how Paul makes clear the relationship between the church and family? How well do you do at this? Are you willing to change?

Wednesday, November 13th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Ephesians 6:1-4 This Scripture talks about the relationship of parents with children and children with parents.

Questions: How well do you do at relating to your parents? How well do you do relating to your children?

Thursday, November 14th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Romans 5:8 God demonstrated His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Questions: Do you think unconditional love is easy? Do you recognize that God's love for us is unconditional? Does this encourage you to be more tolerant of others?

Friday, November 15th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Ecclesiastes 4:9 Two are better than one because they have a good return for their labor.

Questions: How are you at joining another to work together? Do you take advantage of the opportunities at the church to work with others?

Saturday, November 16th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Peter 4:10 We should use our gifts to serve others as faithful stewards of God's grace.

Questions: Do you use your gifts to serve others? Do you realize that even using your gifts in the church is an indirect way to serve others? How will you use your gifts?
