When found, the man hid it, went and sold everything he had to buy the field where he hid it. Questions: Would you sell everything to get the treasure that is in the Kingdom of God? What would you give up in order to quarantee you spend eternity with God? Monday, November 18th (I took time to pray today \square) Read: II Corinthians 5:21 God made Him who had no sin to be sin for us so that we might become the righteousness of God. Questions: Does this verse help you to understand what God did for you? Are you willing to create a regular routine of repenting of your sins? Tuesday, November 19th (I took time to pray today \square) **Read:** Acts 3:19 We should repent and turn to God, so that our sins can be wiped out and times of refreshing may come from the Lord. Questions: How difficult is it for you to go before God and repent of your sins? Do you see how Scripture encourages us to do this and that good things come out of this time? Wednesday, November 20th (I took time to pray today \square) Read: Ephesians 2:8-9 It is by grace that we are saved through faith, not by works.

Questions: Have you struggled with the idea that it is by faith

not works that we become saved? Does this change what you

are doing to earn salvation?

Read: I Corinthians 12:27-28 Each one of us is a part of the body of Christ. And God has appointed each one to be a part of the church. **Questions:** Do you consider yourself to be an Apostle. Prophet, teacher, worker of miracles, have the gift of healing, one who helps others, administrator, or who has the gift of speaking in tongues? Do you struggle with any of these gifts? Do you use these gifts in the body of Christ? Friday, November 22nd (I took time to pray today \square) Read: Matthew 20:26-28 Whoever wants to be greatest among you must be your servant and whoever wants to be first among you must be your slave. **Questions:** How do you think you do at acting like you always need to be served? How are you about getting your own way? The book asks "do you think church membership is a gift"? Saturday, November 23rd (I took time to pray today \square) Read: Hebrews 10:25 Let us not give up meeting together as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another. **Questions:** Do you see we are called to be a part of the church body? Are you the someone who encourages another as part of the body? How confident are you that you will be able to put others first and stop thinking of your own desires? ~~~~~~ Through God's love for us we can't help but want to serve

others and show that love to them. Let us help you explore the

best way for you to show love and serve in your Christian path.


