Sunday, November 3rd (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Timothy 3:2-4 This Scripture is packed with how an overseer (or Pastor) should act.

Questions: How important is prayer to you? How often do you pray for your Pastors? How often do you pray for the church leadership?

Monday, November 4th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Timothy 3:5 A continuation of the above Scripture which asks, if anyone does not know how to manage his own family, how can he care for God's church?

Questions: What do you think of this Scripture? Have you considered what affects the demands of a Pastor have on their families? Are you willing to intercede for them?

Tuesday, November 5th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Timothy 3:7 The Pastor also should have a good reputation with outsiders so that he/she doesn't fall into disgrace and into the devil's trap.

Questions: Do you think Pastors are more prone to temptation than you? Do you see the importance of praying for your Pastors?

Wednesday, November 6th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 2 Timothy 4:2 This Scripture says we are to preach the Word, and be prepared to correct, rebuke, and encourage with great patience and instruction.

Questions: How do you do at this? Maybe you don't preach but are you prepared to correct, rebuke and encourage?

Thursday, November 7th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Acts 20:28 We are to keep watch over ourselves and all the flock that the Holy Spirit has made you an overseer.

Questions: Do you see that you should also pray for the leadership of our church who head committees or other ministry events? Do you need to discern where God might want you to serve?

Friday, November 8th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Hebrews 13:17 We should obey our leaders and submit to their authority. Obey them so that their work will be a joy and not a burden.

Questions: Besides praying, what other ways can we be a support to our leadership? How can you personally show support?

Saturday, November 9th (I took time to pray today)

Read: James 3:1 Those who teach will be judged more strictly.

Questions: Do you see the importance of praying for those who are teaching here at Tabor? Are you willing to commit to this?
