Sunday, December 1st (I took time to pray today □) Read: Matthew 24:36-44 Keep watch, because you do not know on what day Your Lord will come. Questions: Do you feel you are ready if the Lord came and took you home with Him today? What can you do to be ready? Are you willing to do all it takes? Monday, December 2nd (I took time to pray today \square) **Read:** Luke 21:36 We should always be on watch and pray that we will be able to stand against all that is to happen and stand before the Son of Man. **Questions:** What do you have to be on watch for? Are your prayers only about what you need or are they also about being right with God so we can be prepared for when our time comes? Tuesday, December 3rd (I took time to pray today □) Read: 2 Peter 3:10 The day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear, the elements will be destroyed by fire and the earth and everything in it will be laid bare. Questions: How do you feel about what will happen on this day? Will you be fearful or feel at peace because you are confident of where you will go at the final judgment?

Read: 1 Peter 5:8 We should always be on alert because the

enemy prowls around like a lion looking for someone to devour.

Questions: What does being on alert look like to you? Do you

believe there is an enemy looking to come after you? Do you

know the steps you are to take to keep the enemy at bay?

Thursday, December 5th (I took time to pray today \square) **Read:** Ephesians 6:13 This tells us to put on the full armor of God so that when the day comes you will still be able to stand your ground. **Questions:** How well do you do at putting on the armor of God? Do you really believe it protects you? Are you willing to put the armor on daily? Friday, December 6th (I took time to pray today □) Read: 1 Corinthians 16:13 We are told to be on guard, stand strong in your faith, to be men of courage and be strong. **Questions:** Do you find it difficult to do what this Scripture says in the light of adversity? How well do you do at being on guard? What can you do differently? Saturday, December 7th (I took time to pray today \square) Read: Proverbs 27:1 We should not boast about tomorrow because we do not know what a day may bring. Questions: Are you one to boast about something in the future? How does the thought of not knowing what tomorrow brings make you feel? Can you be at peace trusting that God Has everything under control?
