Sunday, December 15th (I took time to pray today \Box)

Read: Matthew 11:2-11 Jesus talks to His Disciples about who John the Baptist is and that they should go to John and report all that is being done.

Questions: How well do you do in telling others about what Jesus has done? Do you think it is important for others to know?

Monday, December 16th (I took time to pray today

Read: Romans 12:6 Talks about all of us having different gifts and that if our gift is prophesying we should use it in proportion to our faith.

Questions: Are you using the gifts that God has given you? If not, why not? If you don't know what they are, are you willing to discover them?

Tuesday, December 17th (I took time to pray today \Box)

Read: 1 Corinthians 13:9 "For we know in part and we prophesy in part."

Questions: Do you realize that any gift given by God is only a small part of what the church needs? Can you see and understand that all of our gifts are needed?

Read: Jeremiah 28:8 This Scripture refers to prophets in the past that have prophesied about various disasters.

Questions: Are you cautious in taking to heart all the prophesies that are spoken? Do you realize that there are both prophets of God and false prophets? How will you discern which is truth?

Thursday, December 19th (I took time to pray today \Box)

Read: Ezekiel 37:7 Ezekiel hears a rattling sound and bones coming together when he was prophesying.

Questions: Do you see God working in your life? Are you open to allowing Him to work in your life? Do you really believe we serve an amazing God? If not, why not?

Friday, December 20th (I took time to pray today \Box)

Read: Acts 2:17 It is the Scripture that was spoken by Joel about God saying that He will pour out His Spirit on all people. It specifically speaks about your sons and daughters will prophesy,

Questions: Do you believe that God can speak to you through others? Do you think He would use a young child as well as an old man? Are you willing to be used by God to speak to another?

Saturday, December 21st (I took time to pray today
)

Read: 1 Corinthians 12:10 This is the part of Romans that talks about Spiritual gifts. This particular verse speaks about the gifts that are given by the Spirit.

Questions: Do you think that these gifts would be awesome to have? Are you willing to accept the awesome gifts, (like miraculous powers) as well as a those that are mysterious (like speaking in tongues)? Do you understand that all gifts are from an awesome God?


