Sunday, January 26th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 4:12-23 This Scripture is when Jesus begins to preach and calls His first Disciples.

Questions: Do you know what Jesus is calling you to do? If you don't, what will you do about it? If you do, are you being obedient?

Monday, January 27th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Isaiah 9:1-4 This Scripture is a prophesy of how the people who are waiting in darkness will see the light when Jesus comes.

Questions: Are you still searching for the light of Jesus? Or have you seen the light of Jesus in your life? Do you see the light even when you feel like you are going through dark times?

Tuesday, January 28th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 27:1 When the Lord is your light, you have nothing to fear. He is also your salvation and stronghold and you don't need to be afraid.

Questions: Do you desire to live a life of fear? If not, how will you live a life in the light, with Jesus your salvation and stronghold? Do you believe it can be done?

Wednesday, January 29th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 27:4-9 This Scripture is a great reminder that we can dwell in the house of the Lord forever and that He will keep us safe from trouble. A great Psalm to read when you are feeling attacked.

Questions: Do you desire to dwell in the house of the Lord forever? Will you take time to seek His face so that you may dwell there? How will you accomplish this?

Thursday, January 30th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Corinthians 1:10-18 Paul says that there should be no division within the church. Our energies should be on preaching the gospel because that message is the power of God.

Questions: Are you willing to allow our differences to be a driving force in working together to preach God's word? Are you willing to preach the gospel to others so that they too can hear the message and have the power of God?

Friday, January 31st (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Peter 2:9-10 We are a chosen generation called out of darkness into His wonderful light.

Questions: Do you remember when you felt called out of darkness into God's wonderful light? If you can remember, wasn't it a life changer for you and something you should share with others?

Saturday, February 1st (I took time to pray today)

Read: Luke 9:1-2 This Scripture reminds us that when Jesus called His disciples, he gave them power and authority to drive out demons, cure diseases and heal the sick.

Questions: Do you believe that this can still happen today? Don't you want to be a part of Jesus' calling so that you can have power and authority? Are you willing to respond to Jesus' calling?

**Tuesday:** God, thank You that You are my Light. Drive fear away from me so that I can be all that You called me to be. Amen.

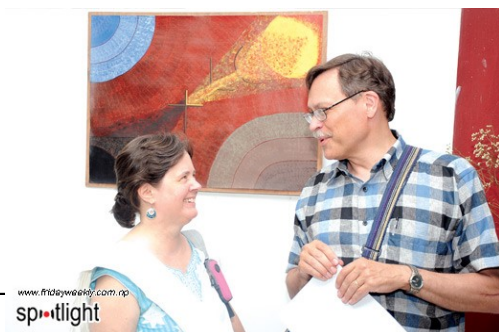
