Sunday, January 5th (I took time to pray today)

Read: John 1:1-18 This Scripture reveals that God always was, and alongside Him, is Jesus. It also reveals what John the Baptist's role was.

Questions: Is it comforting for you to know that God has always been? Isn't it comforting to know that The Word is truth?

Monday, January 6th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Jeremiah 31:7-14 This Scripture shows that God cares for His people and watches over us.

Questions: Do you truly believe that God cares for You and watches over you? Do you live your life knowing this or do you still worry?

Tuesday, January 7th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 147:12-20 We should glorify and praise God for all that He has done and for what He will continue to do.

Questions: Do you believe this Scripture is for you today even though it talks about a particular nation? Are you willing to commit to praise God each time you see Him doing something special for you?

Wednesday, January 8th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Ephesians 1:3-14 Another Scripture pointing out how much God loves us. He adopted us into His family.

Questions: How does it make you feel to know that God has adopted you into His family? Does it change your perspective as to how much God loves you? How will you respond to this?

Thursday, January 9th (I took time to pray today)

Read: John 14:10 This Scripture states that Jesus is in the Father and the Father is in Him. Jesus' words are not His own but His Father's who works through Him.

Questions: Is it comforting to you if you believe in Jesus, knowing that He is the mediator between you and the Father? Do you believe that God speaks to you through the Holy Spirit?

Friday, January 10th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 119:105 God's word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.

Questions: How do you look at God's word? Is it your everything? Or do you only go to it when you are in need of something in particular?

Saturday, January 11th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Luke 11:28 Jesus said that all who hear the word and put it into practice are even more blessed.

Questions: Do you see how important this is since we have heard most of this week all that God desires to do for us? Isn't knowing God's word and hearing it important to you? What will you do about it?
