Sunday, February 9th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 5:13-20 Here we are called both the Salt of the earth and the light of the world.

Questions: How do you see yourself as the salt of the earth or the light of the world? Do you let your light shine before others that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven?

Monday, February 10th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Isaiah 58:1-12 This Scripture gives a list of things we should not do and things we should do.

Questions: Are you the kind of person who needs others to see all that you are doing for the Lord? Or are you the one who responds to God without others knowing?

Tuesday, February 11th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 112:1-9 “Blessed are those who fear the Lord and find great delight in His commands.”

Questions: Do you understand what it means to fear the Lord? It is important to understand this. Do you find great delight in what He commands? Did you see what benefits come from being obedient to this part of Scripture?

Wednesday, February 12th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Corinthians 2:1-12 We can receive God’s wisdom from the Spirit of God.

Questions: Have you heard the Spirit of God reveal things to you? Do you spend time with God so that you do know what God’s wisdom for you is? Will you respond to what you hear from the Spirit?

Thursday, February 13th (I took time to pray today)

Read: John 1:38 This Scripture reveals Jesus turning to the Disciples and saying “What do you want?”

Questions: If you too are following Jesus, what do you want from Him? Do you really believe that He has what you need? Do you really believe that He will provide for you?

Friday, February 14th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Malachi 3:1 The prophecy that the Lord will send His messenger who will prepare the way and then suddenly He will come.

Questions: Are you still in a waiting time for the Lord? Do you believe that He is there for you in all circumstances? What will you do to be reminded of how He has provided for you in the past?

Saturday, February 15th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Chronicles 16:11 “Look to the Lord and His strength; seek His face always.”

Questions: How well do you do at looking to the Lord and His strength? Is it something you can rely on? How well do you do at seeking His face? Are you willing to change things around so that you have time to do this?
