March 15, 2020

Sunday, March 15th

(I took time to pray today \square)

Read: Genesis 45:4-8 This is the story of Joseph, who was sold by his brothers to the Ishmaelites and taken to Egypt. It is the part where Joseph tells his brothers that he was sent to Egypt not by them but by God to save their lives by a great deliverance.

Questions: Have you seen God use your bad situations for good? How does that make you feel? Will you look at those situations differently now?

Monday, March 16th

(I took time to pray today \square)

Read: Romans 8:18 Paul says he considers his present sufferings not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.

Questions: What do you do in your time of suffering? Do you complain about it? Or do you turn to God to see Him in it and remembering who God is to you?

Tuesday, March 17th

(I took time to pray today \square)

Read: Genesis 39:23 "The warden paid no attention to anything under Joseph's care, because the Lord was with Joseph and gave him success in whatever he did."

Questions: How often have you felt God's presence with you when you are going through a difficult time? Have you seen God give you success in the things you have done? Have you shared this with others?

Wednesday, March 18th

(I took time to pray today \square)

Read: Habakkuk 2:19 A Scripture that talks about how lifeless things can not give guidance.

Questions: What or Who do you count on for guidance? Is it God or things that are around you?

Thursday, March 19th

(I took time to pray today \square)

Read: Isaiah 30:21 "Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you saying, 'This is the way; walk in it."

Questions: Do you hear from God? If not, what will you do to make sure that this is something you listen for on a daily basis? If you do, how often are you obedient to His voice?

Friday, March 20th

(I took time to pray today \square)

Read: John 14:26 This Scripture tells us Jesus' promise to us of the Holy Spirit and what the Spirit does in our life.

Questions: Do you believe this promise of Jesus, that the Holy Spirit will teach you all things and will remind you of everything that Jesus has promised? Have you seen this in your life? Have you shared it with another?

Saturday, March 21st

(I took time to pray today \square)

Read: Psalm 32:8 .This passage from Scripture reminds us that the Lord will instruct us and teach us in the way we should go, and will counsel and watch over us.

Questions: Do you turn to the Lord and allow Him to teach and instruct you? Do you allow the Lord to counsel you and watch over you? Can you trust Him to do this?
