Sunday, March 22nd (I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 14:30– 32 This is the part of the Walking on Water Scripture when Peter was walking on water but saw the wind and began to sink. Jesus reached for him and caught him. Jesus said “You of little faith, why did you doubt?”

Questions: Have you felt like you had little faith? Have you found yourself doubting Jesus? What has this Scripture taught you?

Monday, March 23rd (I took time to pray today)

Read: Deuteronomy 31:6 “Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified, because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you, he will never leave you nor forsake you.”

Questions: How difficult is it for you to always be strong and courageous? Does the reminder that no matter what, God goes with you and will never leave you bring you comfort? What will you do with that reminder?

Tuesday, March 24th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 John 4:18 “There is no fear in love. But perfect love casts out all fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.”

Questions: Why do you think Christians live with fear when there is a perfect God who loves them? When you are fearful, what do you do? Can you change your response?

Wednesday, March 25th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 34:4 “I sought the Lord, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears.”

Questions: How quickly do you seek the Lord when you are afraid? Do you try and handle it yourself? Or, do you rely on God? How?

Thursday, March 26th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Ecclesiastes 3:1 “There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens.”

Questions: Do you believe this even when things are not going according to your plans? Do you believe that God has your life under control? If not, why not?

Friday, March 27th (I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Peter 2:9 “But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.”

Questions: Did you know that you are chosen? What does it mean to you to be called out of darkness into His marvelous light? What will you do to show others that you have been chosen?

Saturday, March 28th (I took time to pray today)

Read: Job 42:2 “I know that you can do all things; no purpose of yours can be thwarted.”

Questions: Do you remember what Job went through? Can you believe he continued to trust God and what He knew about Him? Are you willing to trust God because of what you know about Him? Will you stand on the promises He has given us?
