
Sunday, April 19th (I took time to pray today □) Read: Acts 2:14a, 22-32 This Scripture is about the speech Peter gave to the Israelites after the Holy Spirit came when they were all gathered together after Jesus' death. **Questions:** How good are you at telling others about God's love and Christ's death? Do you think it is a story worth telling? What is holding you back? Monday, April 20th (I took time to pray today \square) Read: Psalm 116 This Psalm give testimony that the Lord is with us no matter what we are going through. **Questions:** Do you believe that the Lord hears your voice? Do you become frustrated when you think that the Lord is not listening? Will you remember this Psalm when you feel that way? Tuesday, April 21st (I took time to pray today \square) Read: 1 Peter 1:3-9 Peter talks about the resurrection and the inheritance that we are entitled to in heaven. **Questions:** How does it make you feel knowing that what Christ did for us entitles us to an inheritance in heaven? How does knowing this change how you relate to God? Wednesday, April 22nd (I took time to pray today \square) Read: John 20:19-31 This is the story of Jesus appearing to his Disciples after he died. Thomas was not there the first time and said he needed proof of Jesus' resurrection. Questions: Do you believe in the resurrection? Even if you do, do you believe that Jesus appears through His Spirit to you to-

day? How does this make you feel? Do you still doubt His

speaking and leading in your life today?

Thursday, April 23rd (I took time to pray today \square) Read: John 10:28-30 "I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand. I and the Father are one. Again his Jewish opponents picked up stones to stone him, but Jesus said to them, 'I have shown you many good works from the Father. For which of these do you stone me?" Questions: How does it make you feel knowing that nothing or no one can snatch us out of Jesus or God's hands? Isn't it comforting knowing that the Father is greater than all? Friday, April 24th (I took time to pray today \square) **Read:** 1 John 5:11 "And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his son." Questions: Do you realize that you can receive eternal life through the life of Jesus? Do you have a relationship with Jesus? If you are not sure, will you talk to someone to fine out? Saturday, April 25th (I took time to pray today \square) **Read:** John 3:16 "For God so love the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." **Questions:** Do you have a greater understand of life after death? Do you fear death? Does knowing Jesus and knowing where you are going, take away that fear? If you do fear it, will you talk to someone to have a better understanding of what this means?
