Sunday, April 26th

(I took time to pray today  $\square$ )

**Read:** Acts 2: 14a-36-41 This is a continuation of last Sunday's Scripture when Peter stood up and addressed the crowd. Here it points out that the words Peter spoke really affected them. They asked "Brothers, what shall we do?" Peter replied "Repent and be baptized." He also said to them if they do this, they will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

**Questions:** Do you believe that you have received the gift of the Holy Spirit? Do you know what this means for you? Do you believe that repentance plays a big part of receiving the Holy Spirit?

Monday, April 27th

(I took time to pray today □ )

**Read:** Psalm 116:1-4 In this Psalm, when the Psalmist was overcome with distress and sorrow, he called on the Lord to save him.

**Questions:** What do you do when you feel overcome with distress and sorrow? Do you try to handle it on your own or do you call on the Lord to save you?

Tuesday, April 28th

(I took time to pray today  $\square$ )

**Read:** Psalm 116:12-19 In this part of the Psalm, David wants to know what he can return to the Lord for all his goodness, and then outlines what he should do.

**Questions:** How do you show thanks to the Lord for His goodness? Do you look for ways that You can give thanks? Do you think you should?

Wednesday, April 29th

(I took time to pray today  $\square$ )

**Read:** 1 Peter 1:17-23 A message of how we are redeemed by God.

**Questions:** Do you still think it is what you do rather than through Jesus' blood that you are redeemed? If it is the latter,

what are you doing to develop that relationship with Jesus?

Thursday, April 30th

(I took time to pray today  $\Box$ )

**Read:** Luke 24:13-35 This is the story of Jesus walking along with the Disciples, but they did not recognize Him. Instead they just told him the story of Jesus and his crucifixion and resurrection.

**Questions:** How often do you miss that it is Jesus walking with you? How long does it take for you to recognize that it is Him? How do you respond?

Friday, May 1st

(I took time to pray today  $\square$ )

**Read:** Acts 10:48 "So he ordered that they be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. Then they asked Peter to stay with them for a few days."

**Questions:** Have you had a Holy Spirit baptism? Do you recognize that it is different than the water baptism you had as a baby? What is the difference in your life?

Saturday, May 2nd

(I took time to pray today □)

**Read:** Luke 3:16 ."John answered them all, 'I baptize you with water. But one who is more powerful than I will come, the straps of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy spirit and fire."

**Questions:** Did you realize that there are two kinds of baptism? Which one have you had? Can you express to another what the difference is between the two and what it means for your life?
