Sunday, May 24th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Luke 24:44-53 This Scripture is about Jesus appearing to the Disciples after His death. He reminds them of His death and that He is going to send them what the Father has promised.

Questions: How do you interpret Jesus's statement about "Power from on High"? What does this mean for you?

Monday, May 25th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Acts 1:1-11 This is the Scripture stating that Jesus appeared to the Disciples several times after His death. But it mentions the gift that was promised, a baptism of the Holy Spirit.

Questions: What do you know about the Holy Spirit? Do you think that you have to have a baptism of the Spirit in order to receive Him?

Tuesday, May 26th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: John 14:2 "My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you?"

Questions: Do you like this promise of Jesus that He would be going on ahead of the Disciples to prepare a place for them in heaven? How does that make you feel when you think of that promise for yourself?

Wednesday, May 27th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Ephesians 1:15-23 In this Scripture, Paul lets the Ephesians know of what he is praying for them. One of those is that they would receive the Spirit of Wisdom.

Questions: How would you like someone to be praying these things over you? Did you know that you can use Scripture to be a personal prayer?

Thursday, May 28th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Mark 16:19 "After the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, he was taken up into heaven and he sat at the right hand of God.."

Questions: How does this make you feel? Are you comforted that Jesus' sits at the right hand of His Father? Will this change your prayer life?

Friday, May 29th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: John 16:28 "I came from the Father and entered the world; now I am leaving the world and going back to the Father."

Questions: Do you see that this verse confirms some of the promises that Jesus made? Will this help you to trust the promises of Jesus more?

Saturday, May 30th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Timothy 3:16 "Beyond all question, the mystery from which true godliness springs is great: He appeared in the flesh, was vindicated by the Spirit, was seen by angels, was preached among the nations, was believed in the world, was taken up in glory."

Questions: Do you see that even Paul confirms in his letter to Timothy what Jesus promised? Does this help strengthen your trusting Jesus?
