Sunday, May 3rd

(I took time to pray today)

Read: John 10:1-10 This Scripture is the one where Jesus talks about sheep and how they only listen to the shepherd's voice. He also related this to how He is the way to salvation.

Questions: How well do you do at recognizing Jesus' voice? How well do you accept and understand that Jesus is the way to salvation?

Monday, May 4th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Acts 2:42-47 This is the story in Acts of how there was fellowship of the believers after the Holy Spirit came down to them. It shares how they lived with one another.

Questions: Would you struggle with having all that you have be in common with others? Would you struggle with selling all your possessions so that you could give to anyone who had need?

Tuesday, May 5th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 23:1 "The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing."

Questions: Sure, this is a simple statement, but how do you respond when you feel you have lost everything? Do you trust Jesus or are you filled with worry and fear?

Wednesday, May 6th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Peter 2:19-25 A reminder of what Jesus endured. But also a comment of how we would handle being punished for something we did not do.

Questions: Is it hard for you to be accused and then punished for something that you did not do? How do you handle that? As we learn about sheep and shepherds, how does it make you feel knowing that Christ's death allowed us to return to the Shepherd?

Thursday, May 7th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: John 14:6 "Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'"

Questions: Do you see that it is important to have a relationship with Jesus in order to get to the Father? At this point, can you distinguish between God as Father, God as Son, God as Holy Spirit? Can you explain this to another?

Friday, May 8th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Romans 10:9 "If you declare with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

Questions: Again, do you see the importance of having a relationship with Jesus? Are you one who only prays to God and not to Jesus?

Saturday, May 9th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Timothy 2:5 "For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus,...."

Questions: Do you see that Jesus is the mediator between you and God? Does this change things in how you relate to God? Does this make you less afraid of God, knowing you can go through Jesus to get to Him?

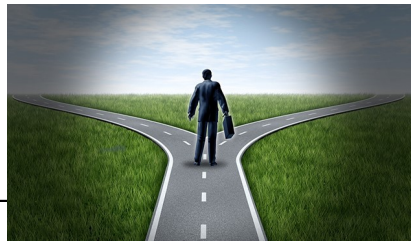
