Sunday, June 14th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 9:35-38 This Scripture speaks about all Jesus was doing. He saw that they were harassed and helpless and told them to ask the Lord of the harvest to send out workers in his harvest field.

Questions: When there seems to be so much to do in the church, do you ask the Lord to send workers? How would you respond if the Lord sent you out?

Monday, June 15th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 10:1-4 Jesus gave authority to His 12 Disciples and gave them authority to drive out impure spirits and heal disease and sickness.

Questions: Do you believe that Jesus has given you authority? What has Jesus called you to do? Were you obedient?

Tuesday, June 16th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 10:5-15 Jesus gives instructions to the Disciples who He sent out.

Questions: Do you trust that Jesus would give you instructions if He called you to go out in His name? Do you believe that He would give you all you need to do His ministry?

Wednesday, June 17th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 10:16-23 This Scripture talks about Jesus describing all that can happen while they are sent out.

Questions: Do you see how this Scripture makes being sent out not pleasant? Even if you answered yes, do you believe that Jesus will be with you when He sends you out? Does that give you the courage to be sent out?

Thursday, June 18th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Genesis 18:1-15 This is the story where the Lord appeared to Abraham. Abraham saw Him as three men. He waited on the men and gave them something to eat and drink. And then the Lord promises that he and his wife would have a son.

Questions: How are you at recognizing the Lord? Are you one to be on the lookout for strangers that you can help? Does knowing that it could be the Lord rather than a stranger, change how you will treat strangers in the future?

Friday, June 19th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 116:1-2 "I love the Lord, for he heard my voice; he heard my cry for mercy. Because he turned his ear to me, I will call on him as long as I live."

Questions: Do you believe that the Lord hears your voice? Do you believe that the Lord turns His ear to you? Does this change the way you will relate to the Lord?

Saturday, June 20th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Romans 5:1-8 This Scripture talks about who Christ died for. It also reminds us that since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Questions: What do you think of the verse "And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us? Can you see how much God loves you through these verses?"
