**Sunday, June 28th**

(I took time to pray today )

**Read: Deuteronomy 31:1-13** This Scripture talks about the transition that takes place from Moses to Joshua.

**Questions:** How are you with transition or change? Did you ever think that it is a way that God is teaching you to trust Him and that He has it all in His control?

**Monday, June 29th**

(I took time to pray today )

**Read: Hebrews 12:1-3** This Scripture reminds us that we are to persevere in the race of life but fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith.

**Questions:** What does it take to fix your eyes on Jesus? If you do this, how does that change around your situations in life? If it is a good thing, why don't you do it more often?

**Tuesday, June 30th**

(I took time to pray today )

**Read: Jeremiah 29:11** "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

**Questions:** Do you trust God in all of the plans He has for you? Or do you not even pay attention to those plans and just go forward on your own?

**Wednesday, July 1st**

(I took time to pray today )

**Read: Joshua 1:9** "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid, do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

**Questions:** What does this verse speak to you? Do you believe that God has this command for you too? Do you live your life like you really believe this?

**Thursday, July 2nd**

(I took time to pray today )

**Read: Proverbs 3:5-6** "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him and he will make your paths straight."

**Questions:** How difficult is this for you? Do you struggle not understanding why God may be doing something? Have you gotten to a place where you trust Him with all your situations?

**Friday, July 3rd**

(I took time to pray today )

**Read: Isaiah 43:19** "See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland."

**Questions:** If God is the one doing the new thing, will you believe that He has only good in mind and that it will be okay? Do you believe that He will make a way in the wilderness and provide streams in the wasteland of life?

**Saturday, July 4th**

(I took time to pray today )

**Read: James 1:17** "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows."

**Questions:** Do you believe that "every good and perfect gift is from above"? Do you believe that He does not change? If you struggle with these, are you willing to do something about it?

**Monday:** Lord, sometimes I need Your help in persevering through life's challenges. I look to You now so that I can sense Your peace in the midst of changes. Amen.

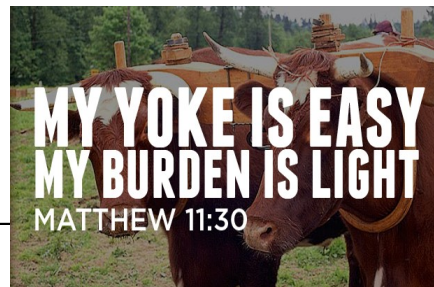
**Tuesday:** God, thank You that You have plans for me. Help me to trust You as I watch those plans unfold. Amen.
