Sunday, June 7th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 28:16-20 This Scripture is known as The Great Commission.

Questions: How are you in going out and making disciples of all nations? Do you see that we are called to baptize them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit? Why do you think it is Important for us to share about all three?

Monday, June 8th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Genesis 1:1-2:4 This is the story of Creation.

Questions: I am sure you have read or heard this story many times. Did anything new stick out for you as you read it today? Did you remember that it says that “the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters”? What does this say to you?

Tuesday, June 9th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 8 David reminisces on all that God created and how majestic is the Lord’s name.

Questions: How does this speak to you as you look at Creation through the eyes of David? Do you agree with David when he says “Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!

Wednesday, June 10th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 2 Corinthians 13:11-13 Paul gives final greetings to the Corinthians telling them to encourage one another, be of one mind and live in peace.

Questions: Do you find it difficult to be encouraging to others? Do you find it difficult to be of one mind with others in the church family? Is it difficult to live in peace?

Thursday, June 11th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 1 Corinthians 8:6 “...yet for us there is but one God, the Father, from whom all things came and for whom we live; and there is but one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things came and through whom we live.”

Questions: Do you struggle with worshiping one God? Or do you allow other things to take control? Did you know that idolatry is something that we give more attention to rather than focusing on God?

Friday, June 12th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Colossians 2:9 “For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form,…”

Questions: Is this Scripture saying anything to you that is different than what you thought? How is it speaking to you?

Saturday, June 13th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: John 1:14 “The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father full of grace and truth.”

Questions: Do you recognize that the Word is talking about Jesus? Do you see the characteristics that John has placed on Jesus? Does this give you a different view of Jesus than you had thought of before?
