Sunday, July 12th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Matthew 13:1-9, 18-23 This Scripture is the parable about the Sower and then an explanation by Jesus of what this parable means.

Questions: What do you do with God's word? Do you receive It with joy but only allow this joy for a short time, do you let deceitfulness or worries of this life choke it away or are you a person who understands it so that you produce good from it?

Monday, July 13th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: 2 Timothy 3:16-17 "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

Questions: Do you see the importance of being in God's word and allowing it to teach you? Do you consider God's word something that equips you for good work?

Tuesday, July 14th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Psalm 119:10-11 "I seek you with all my heart; do not let me stray from your commands. I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you."

Questions: Have you ever thought that knowing God's word and keeping it in your heart would help control your temptation to sin? Does that change how you look at God's word?

Wednesday, July 15th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: John 1:1-8 This Scripture reminds us that "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God and the Word was God."

Questions: Knowing the importance of God's word, isn't it incentive to be in it more regularly? Doesn't reading His word remind you of who God is and how much He loves you?

Thursday, July 16th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: 2 Corinthians 9:10-11 "Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness. You will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God."

Questions: Do you consider yourself generous on every occasion? When you are blessed, do you then go and bless others? Isn't that what we are called to do?

Friday, July 17th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Joshua 1:8 "Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Them you will be prosperous and successful."

Questions: Do you see the benefit of meditating on God's Word? Do you see the importance of doing everything written in it?

Saturday, July 18th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Romans 15:4 "For everything that was written in the past was written to teach us, so that through the endurance taught in the Scriptures and the encouragement they provide we might have hope."

Questions: Have you found hope in reading God's word? What other advantages have you received in studying God's word?
