August 2, 2020

Sunday, August 2nd

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Matthew 14:13-21 This is the story of Jesus's feeding the 5,000 people gathered to hear Him by blessing 5 loaves and 2 fish.

Questions: Do you believe that Jesus still performs miracles today? Are you a person looking for those miracles or are you taken by surprise by them? What would change your mind if you don't believe in miracles today?

Monday, August 3rd

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Mark 6:30-44 This is Mark's version of the same story as yesterday. However, we hear the reason to leave is to find a quiet place and get some rest.

Questions: Do you see the difference between the two versions of the same story? Do you see in this version Jesus wants His Disciples to go off to a quiet place and get some rest with Him? Don't you think that if Jesus cared for His Disciples He also cares about you? Do you need a quiet place and rest?

Tuesday, August 4th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Genesis 18:14 "Is anything too hard for the Lord? I will return to you at the appointed time next year, and Sarah will have a son."

Questions: How would you respond to the question "Is anything too hard for the Lord?" Do you sometimes act like you don't believe this? What will get you to the level that you do believe this in all things?

Wednesday, August 5th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: John 3":27 "John answered and said, 'A man can receive nothing unless it has been given to him from heaven."

Questions: Do you believe that God has gifts He desires to give you? What will you do with those gifts? Will you use them to show others what God can do?

Thursday, August 6th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Ephesians 2:10 "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."

Questions: What good works is God preparing in advance for you to do? Are you willing to do it or do you think they are impossible? Will you trust God with what He is calling you to do?

Friday, August 7th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Philippians 4:13 "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

Questions: Do you believe this? Do you act like you believe this? Do you need to strengthen your trust in God? Will you begin to do this today?

Saturday, August 8th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Psalm 23:1-3 "The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, he refreshes my soul. He guides me along the right paths for his name's sake."

Questions: Can you feel the desire that God has for you? Are you willing to take time to have your soul refreshed? What will it take for you to feel this way? Will you do it? Will you begin today?
