Sunday, October 4th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 4:4 “Jesus answered, ‘It is written: Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God.’”

Questions: Do you live by God’s word by obeying God’s word? Where do you struggle with this? Do you continue to complain to God when He doesn’t give you the “food” that you want?

Monday, October 5th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Deuteronomy 32:46-47 “...he said to them, ‘Take to heart all the words I have solemnly declared to you this day, so that you may command your children to obey carefully all the words of this law. They are not just idle words for you—they are your life. By them you will live in the land you are crossing the Jordan to possess.’”

Questions: Do you take to heart God’s word which contains His promises? Do you see that these words are not idle words? That they are your life?

Tuesday, October 6th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 2 Peter 1:1-4 This Scripture tells us that Jesus, through His divine power, has given us everything we need for a godly life.

Questions: Do you really believe that you have been given His very great and precious promises? Do you always act as if you believe this? Why not? What can you do change?

Wednesday, October 7th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Luke 16:10 “Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much.”

Questions: What do you do with what God has given you? Can God trust you with all you have been given or do you use it for dishonest purposes? Do you use it for God’s ministry?

Thursday, October 8th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Hebrews 4:12-13 ‘For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Nothing in all creation is hidden from God’s sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.’”

Questions: Is it hard knowing that nothing is hidden from God’s sight? Does it make you want to change anything you are doing? Do you feel you are doing enough for God?

Friday, October 9th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Philippians 4:13 “I can do all this through him who gives me strength.”

Questions: Do you live like you believe this? Or, do you shy away from some of the things God is calling you to do? How do you do with trusting Him with your finances? Do you believe He can change that situation around?

Saturday, October 10th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: James 1:5 “If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God who gives generously to all without finding fault and it will be given to you.”

Questions: Do you think that God will only give you wisdom? Don’t you think His promises contain so much more than this? Do you ask Him for the things you lack? Do you then trust He will give generously?

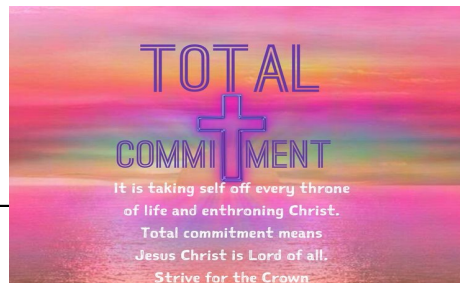
