Sunday, October 25th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Jeremiah 29:11 “For I know the plans I have for you,’ declares the Lord, ‘plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”

Questions: Don’t you think that this is a great Scripture for you to memorize? Isn’t it comforting knowing that God has plans for each one of us and His plans are good? Can you trust what this Scripture says?

Monday, October 26th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Ephesians 2:10 “For we are God’s handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.”

Questions: How does it make you feel knowing that you are God’s handiwork? How well do you do at doing good works for Christ Jesus? How does it make you feel knowing that God prepared in advance the good works you are to do?

Tuesday, October 27th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Joshua 1:8 “Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.”

Questions: Do you pick and choose what you want to obey in God’s word? Do you find it difficult to obey all of what God’s Book says? Don’t you think that God will give us a break for at least trying to keep all of the law? Are you willing to try and keep as much of it as possible?

Wednesday, October 28th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: John 15:4 “Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself, it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me.”

Questions: Are you joined to Christ spiritually? What do you think this looks like? Are you trying to keep connected to the vine at all times? Do you desire to bear fruit in the ministry you do?

Thursday, October 29th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 46:10 “He says, ‘Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth.’”

Questions: How well do you do at being still? What have you seen God do in your life that you desire to exalt Him? How well do you do at being thankful for what God has done?

Friday, October 30th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 25:23 “His master replied, ‘Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master’s happiness!’”

Questions: Have you longed for God to say this about you? Have you ever heard God say to you “Well done, good and faithful servant!?” Wouldn’t that be a day maker?

Saturday, October 31st

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Psalm 37:4-5 “Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him and he will do this.”

Questions: Can you see that God only wants good for you? How does this make you feel? Doesn’t this encourage you to do more for Him? What are you willing to do?

**Monday:** Lord, speak clearly to me this week so I know with certainty the good works You want me to do. Amen.

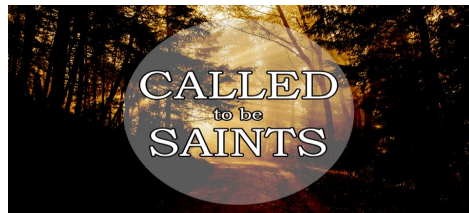
**Tuesday:** Jesus, bring to mind frequently what I have studied in Your word so that I can always be prepared to remember Your promises contained in it. Amen.
