November 1, 2020

Sunday, November 1st

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Romans 1:7 "To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace and peace to you from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ."

Questions: Did you know that the Greek word translated Saints means "set apart one" or "holy one""? Do you consider yourself to be set apart or holy? Do you think it is hard to become set apart or holy?

Monday, November 2nd

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: 1 Peter 1:15-16 "But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy".

Questions: Do you see that we are called to be holy or set apart? What would this look like in your life? Are you willing to try?

Tuesday, November 3rd

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: 1 Timothy 1:9 "He has saved us and called us to a holy life — not because of anything we have done, but because of His own purpose and grace."

Questions: Do you see that we don't have to do anything special to save us and to lead a holy life? Do you see that we are called because of His own purpose and grace? Are you willing to find out what that purpose is?

Wednesday, November 4th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Ephesians 4:24 "And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness."

Questions: What are you willing to change and become new in your life? Do you see that your new life has freed you from sin? How does this make you feel?

Thursday, November 5th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: 2 Corinthians 5:17 "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come.: The old is gone, the new is here!"

Questions: What do you think it looks like to be "in Christ"? Are you? Do you see that is what we need in order to be made new? Does this look like it makes it easier to be set apart or holy?

Friday, November 6th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Psalm 30:4 "Sing unto the Lord, O ye Saints, of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness."

Questions: Do you see "O ye Saints, of his"? How do you feel about this? Do you think this means you are called to be a saint? Do you sing unto the Lord? Do you give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness? What would this look like in your life?

Saturday, November 7th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Micah 6:8 "He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God."

Questions: Can you see this as one way to be holy? Do you act justly? Do you love mercy? Do you walk humbly with your God? Are you willing to try and do what He has shown us?
