Sunday, December 20th

Monday, December 21st

Read: Samuel 7:11-16 In this Scripture God gives David an incredible promise when He tells David that he will not be the one to build a temple.

Questions: Where have you seen God keeping His promise in your life? Is this something you have shared with another? Don't you think it would encourage another to hear about it?

Read: Luke 2:10-11 "But the angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in that town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord."

Questions: Did you realize that God can send His promises through angels or other people? Will you be on the look out for where you will see His promises?

Wednesday, December 23rd

Read: Hebrews 10:23 "Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful."

Questions: How have you seen God's faithfulness in your life? How well do you do at holding on unswervingly to the hope you profess?

Thursday, December 24th

Read: Genesis 12:2-3 "I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all peoples on earth will be blessed through you."

Questions: Do you see the promise that God made to Abraham? If you know Abraham's story, do you see that these promises were fulfilled? Does this help you to believe He will keep His promises to you?

Friday, December 25th

(I took time to pray today □)

Read: Hebrews 11:11 "And by faith even Sarah, who was past childbearing age, was enabled to bear children because she considered him faithful who had made the promise."

Questions: Is your faith strong enough to believe He is faithful to keep His promises? If not, are you willing to change this? If it is, are you willing to praise Him for keeping His promises?

Saturday, December 26th


(I took time to pray today □)
