Sunday, December 27th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Genesis 1:1 “In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.”

Questions: Do you believe God created the perfect kingdom? Even though we see an imperfect kingdom in our world, do you truly believe that God’s plan is good and perfect?

Monday, December 28th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Genesis 12:1-3 “The Lord said to Abram, ‘Go from your country, your people and your father’s household to the land I will show you. I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and all people on earth will be blessed through you.’”

Questions: Do you see this as a restoring of the promises that God made back when He created a perfect kingdom? What kind of blessings have you seen God provide in your life?

Tuesday, December 29th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: 2 Samuel 7:11-14 Here God makes a promise to David that from his descendants will come the Messiah.

Questions: Do you consider this Scripture to be about a promised kingdom? Did you know that other prophets also tell of this promised kingdom? How does it make you feel that God’s promises were fulfilled then?

Wednesday, December 30th

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Jeremiah 23:5-8 This Scripture is Jeremiah’s prophecy about the coming Savior coming out of David’s descendants.

Questions: How does it make you feel knowing that God talked to His people? Has He spoken to you? Do you trust His voice? Are you willing to make listening a priority in 2021?

Thursday, December 31st

(I took time to pray today)

Read: Matthew 4:17 “From that time on Jesus began to preach, ‘Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near.’”

Questions: Do you see this as a chance for people to choose what they will do? Do you remember that the people decided to reject Jesus? What would you have done in a similar situation?

Friday, January 1, 2021

Read: Matthew 28: 16-20 This familiar Scripture is known as the Great Commission. We are to go out into the world and make Disciples.

Questions: How well do you do at making Disciples? As we come through this season of remembering what God has done for you, doesn’t it make you want to go out and tell others?

Read: Revelation 19:16 “On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written” King of kings and Lord of lords.”

Questions: Having this written on His robe, do you recognize how powerful our God is? Do you recognize the difference between Jesus as a baby and now being known as the King of kings and Lord of Lords? Are you willing to change your perspective of our God is?
